Estrogen's Storm Season; stories of perimenopause

wins a 2006 Independent Publisher Book Award

The 2006 Independent Book Awards has named Estrogen's Storm Season; stories of perimenopause as one of three award winners in the **HEALTH** category for the best independently published book in North America.

Published by the Centre for Menstrual Cycle and Ovulation Research (CeMCOR) of UBC and VCHRI, the book has also been on the BC bestsellers list three times in the last 10 months. Written by well-known Professor of Medicine and researcher **Dr. Jerilynn Prior**, the book won over other US and Canadian titles as a finalist in the health category for this year's best independently published title. There was one winner and two finalists in the category.
